We are a bilingual forest and nature school located in Clarence Creek. Our philosophy is rooted in learning through play and exploration, guided by the children's own curiosity. We tailor our programs and camps to empower them to feel a sense of ownership and control over their lives. Through our activities, children learn about themselves—their emotions, their bodies, and the important messages they convey.

Job Responsibilities:

- Following the direction of the lead facilitator, the summer camp counselor will be responsible for helping set-up, run and clean up the activities throughout the day.
- Supervise children to ensure they are respecting themselves and each other as well as being safe.
- Capitalizes on learning opportunities as they arise without prompting from other facilitators.
- Ensures we respect the forest, nature and cabin where we are located.
- Follow all emergency procedures.
- Supervises snack and meal times.
- Assist children in getting their lunch boxes, changing wet mitts, gathering their dry clothes to change into if needed, reminding them to take a drink of water, ect.

Working Hours

Facilitators are asked to be at the cabin by 8:15am each working day to help set up the space and greet the children who will be dropped off at 9:00am.

Children are picked up at 3:00pm and we ask that facilitators stay until 3:30pm to clean up the space and get ready for the following day.

Working Conditions

Our forest and nature school is primarily run outdoors no matter what weather conditions. We do have a cabin that is used as a teaching space and a space to escape the outdoors for a short break depending on the weather but we encourage everyone to be outside as much as possible. We have a compost toilet in the cabin as well as access to flushable toilets.
